In 1984, Rich Wandschneider founded Pika Press to publish a collection of poetry by Wallowa valley farmer Betty Cornwell. Then came the reprinting of *Nature Rambles*, a natural history of the Wallowas. Other books by local authors followed, including works by Grace Bartlett, a historian who used personal interviews and original sources to document the evolution of human settlement and displacement in the Wallowas. Pika Press has also published the *Fishtrap Anthology* for ten years, which features the works of those participating in various events sponsored by Fishtrap, the non-profit literary organization centered in Wallowa County, Oregon.

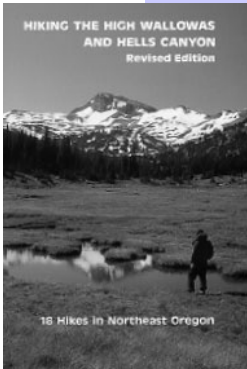
Returns Policy

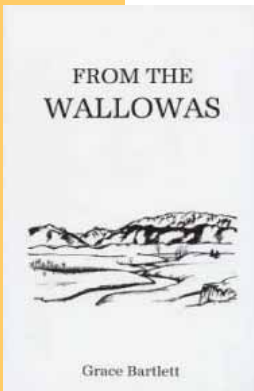

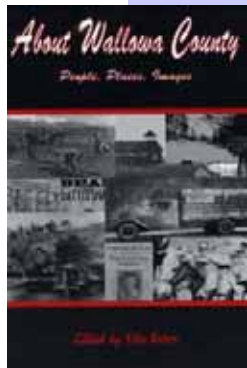
